

BOIL WATER NOTICE

City of Breckenridge, Texas

Effective 10-06-14

Due to conditions which have occurred overnight in the water system, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required the system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. The Boil Water Notice will be in effect for a minimum of 48 hours. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will notify you through the local newspaper, and television and radio stations.

During the early morning hours of 10-06-14 a 14" water main broke draining all overhead and ground storage tanks before crews could isolate the break.
