RE: Organizational Meeting for the Breckenridge Aquatic Center for 2021

I am requesting that you attend a meeting on Thursday, May 13, 2021, at 5:00 P.M. here at the City Offices. It is my understanding that you have filed an application for employment with the City of Breckenridge as a certified lifeguard for this summer.

This will be a very important meeting for the prospective lifeguards for the City of Breckenridge. I have set this meeting at 5:00 P.M., in order that you may be able to attend after school hours. Please bring your Driver's License or ID card and Social Security card. Should you have any problems attending this meeting, it is most important that I hear from you prior to the meeting. Anyone that we do not hear from, or who does not attend this meeting, will be presumed uninterested in working for the City of Breckenridge this summer.

The City of Breckenridge will have training class, starting May 17 - 20 from 5:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. each night.

### Pool Manager Qualification Requirements:

- Minimum age is 21
- Maturity to understand the serious nature of the JOB
- Must pass drug screening
- Complete Lifeguard Training School and receive the following:
  - First Aid and CPR Certification
  - Red Cross Lifeguard Certification
  - CPO certification

### Lifeguard Qualification Requirements:

- Minimum age is 16
- Maturity to understand the serious nature of the JOB
- Must pass drug screening
- Complete Lifeguard Training School and receive the following:
  - First Aid and CPR Certification
  - Red Cross Lifeguard Certification

The cost for the Lifeguard class is \$200. The City will cover the cost for Breckenridge applicants. The cost to be recertified is \$75. The Lifeguard Certification, which includes CPR, AED and First Aid, will be good for two years. The pay rate for managers is \$12.00 and for lifeguards is \$10.00. Should you have any questions, please give me a call, and we will discuss this meeting. We will be going into details on all operations and expectations of our guards for the upcoming season.
