

NOTICE OF 2017 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE

A tax rate of \$ 1.03650 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption to the governing body of the City of Breckenridge. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$ 1.03650 per \$100
PRECEDING YEAR'S TAX RATE	\$ 1.04000 per \$100
EFFECTIVE TAX RATE	\$ 1.01942 per \$100
ROLLBACK TAX RATE	\$ 1.06310 per \$100

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City of Breckenridge from the same properties in both the 2016 tax year and the 2017 tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that the City of Breckenridge may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE ABOVE RATES CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
