INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

10. Request to consider approval of 183 N TxDOT project Engineering Service Agreement with e-HT.

Sage Diller with e-HT, stated this is like the last two that we have done. I have provided you cost estimates and maps to show utility lines on 183 N from Walker to N 287. All water and sewer lines need to be relocated and anything that crosses needs to be steel incased like prior projects. This will be a stand-alone project. The City is going to bid this out and hire a utility contractor. Utility contractor will go out and do relocation and then bid out the road way project. There are pros and cons both ways. It is more like a City project. City Manager McCuistion stated the City will only have to pay 10% of this project, we just have to do most of the foot work.

Commissioner Blue made a motion, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Cyprian, to consider approval of 183 N TxDOT project Engineering Service Agreement with e-HT. When the motion was put to vote, it prevailed as follows: Ayes: Cyprian, Blue and Durham. Nays: None. Absent: McKay and Wimberley.

11. Request to consider Walker Sayle water and sewer rates.

City Manager McCuistion stated he provided a narrative followed by some options of rates.

We have the new schedules posted in the water office and online at the City website and Breckenridge Texan website.

13. Items from the City Commission not requiring formal action: None


14. Adjourn


