CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE GENERAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS
SET FOR SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2020

The Election Day for the City of Breckenridge General & Special Election will be Saturday, May 2, 2020. The Places on the ballot this year are Mayor, City Commission, Place 1 and Place 2 and proposition for the adoption of a local sales and use tax in City of Breckenridge at the rate of one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of one percent (1%) to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. **The polling location for election day will be held in the City Commission Chambers at 105 North Rose Avenue. The polling location for early voting will be held at the City Offices at 105 North Rose Avenue.**

All of the eligible voters of the City of Breckenridge may vote for all of the positions.

The last day that an individual may register to vote for the Saturday, May 2, 2020 General Election is Thursday, April 2, 2020. To register to vote, you will need to go to the Stephens County Tax Office/Voter Registrar's office and they will have the voter registration applications. If you have lost your voter's registration card, you can call the Stephens County Tax Office/Voter Registrar at 254-559-2732 or 254-559-6513 and they will be happy to issue you a duplicate card. If you have moved, you will need to go by the Stephens County Tax Office/Voter Registrar and fill out an address change form. You will need your driver's license number, DPS Personal ID Card, or the last (4) digits of your social security number to make any of the above changes or to register to vote.

Election workers will no longer be allowed to swear to the identity of a voter, so the voter must have one of the following forms of ID as required by the Secretary of State:

- *Texas Driver License issued by the Department of Public Safety (DPS); **NOTE:** This form of ID should not be used if "Limited Term" or "Temporary Visitor" appears on the face of the card as this indicates the person is not a U.S. Citizen
- *Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS
- *Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS; **NOTE:** This form of ID should not be used if "Limited Term" or "Temporary Visitor" appears on the face of the card as this indicates the person is not a U.S. Citizen
- *Texas License to Carry a Handgun issued by DPS
- *United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph
- *United States Citizenship Certificate/Certificate of Naturalization containing the person's photograph
- *United States Passport; **NOTE:** A "passport card" which is also issued by the U.S. Department of State, is acceptable

Early voting by personal appearance begins Monday, April 20th and will continue through Tuesday, April 28th. Early Voting will be held from 8 AM - 5 PM except for April 20th and 21st will be from 6 AM - 6 PM. Early voting will be conducted at the City Offices, 105 North Rose Avenue.
