(Candidate Information)

The Election Day for the City of Breckenridge offices will be Saturday, May 2, 2020. Candidates filing for Places in the Breckenridge City election officially begins Wednesday, January 15, 2020 and will continue until 5:00 P.M., Friday, February 14, 2020. The Places up for election this year are Mayor, and City Commission – Place 1 and Place 2.

All of the eligible voters in Breckenridge may vote for all of the positions. Any qualified resident of Breckenridge may file in the City Secretary's office for any of the races. Qualifications for all candidates for office in Breckenridge include:

- (1) Be a United States Citizen;
- (2) Be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable;
- (3) Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be: totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;
- (4) Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- (5) Have resided continuously in the State for 12 months and in the territory from which the office is elected for 6 months immediately preceding the date of the filing deadline;
- (6) Be a registered voter in the territory from which the office is elected as of the date of the filing deadline for a candidate's place on the ballot.
