### **The City Manager is declaring Stage 4 Emergency Water Shortage Conditions due to treatment issues at the Water Treatment Plant**

## **A BOIL WATER NOTICE**

**City of Breckenridge, Texas**

**Effective 08-05-16**

Due to conditions which have occurred in the water system, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required the system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

The Boil Water Notice will be in effect for a minimum of 48 hours. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will notify you through the local newspaper, and television and radio stations.
